

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Grand Rapids, MI





PAYT \$35 per item

- Pre-pay online & schedule OR
- Buy sticker at participating stores or city hall
- o Items are picked up 3 days within regularly scheduled service day



Fayetteville, AR





- 8 bulky waste cleanups per year (4 in spring, 4 in fall)
 - o 2 drop-off locations per event (not curbside)
- 1 free pickup per year per single-family and duplexes
 - Curbside <u>one category (Bulk household, Metal or Brush)</u> OR
 - Bring 5 items of any category for free to the Transfer Station (utility bill and license required)
- Additional pick-ups of up to 5 items from 1 category can be scheduled for \$60.53+tax

Sevierville, TN (unique regional MSW facility)



- Every other week collection, published as "at least once per month"
- Code "not more than one truck load"

"regularly observed amounts" at house



Several minutes later....



Kingsport, TN

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• Bulk/Brush collected together every other week





- Carpet \$25/pickup
- Building Materials \$82/ton
- Move out pile \$100

Very small pickups, too

Chatham County GA

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• Once/month Bulk collection curbside plus "free" self-haul to drop-off



Columbia, MO





Before 11/2/2020

- Unlimited setouts at curb
- Manual collection with rearloader

Since 11/2/2020

- Call in and schedule
 - One free item per year
 - \$21.50 first additional
 item + \$5/each additional
 item per scheduled pickup
- Manual collection with rearloader



Guiding Principles

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Select Collection Technology









Determine Collection Frequency



- Scheduled within regular services Weekly, bimonthly, quarterly, semi-annually, etc.
- On-call, scheduled by citizen Phone, online, app, etc.
- Combination of baseline + options for additional items

"X item(s)/Yr"

"Every Other Week"

"X cleanups/Yr"

"Bring to Drop-off"

"Monthly"

Establish Setout Limitations



- Per item count
- Per volume
- Per amount of time
- Number of grabs

"Up to X cubic yards"

"Up to 2 minutes"

"Up to half a pickup bed"

"Up to 2 grapple buckets"

Set Fee Structure



Based on established setout limits

- Part of base service fee
- Pre-pay purchase tags or pay when scheduled
- Cost per item(s), minutes, knuckleboom grabs, etc.





Administrative & Management Considerations



- Can call-in center support added calls?
- Can customer bills be adjusted easily for variable rate pricing?
- Do you have software to support/automate as much of the scheduling and billing as possible?

Large item collection

Collection of large items will be provided for residential customers receiving curbside collection.

To arrange a pickup of bulky items or major appliances, complete the online request form through the CoMo Recycle and Trash app. For more information, call 573.874.2489 or visit the Large Item Collection page.

Purchasing a Bulk Collection Request

- The cost per item is \$35.
- Request and pay for a collection online Use the Online Request Form (link below). You will need to pay the fee prior to completing the request. Make sure to have a credit card handy.

Use our online form to request bulk item and appliance pickup.

Order Online

Before putting your items on the curb, please call the Recycling and Trash Collection Division by phone at 479-575-8398 to schedule a pick-up. The schedule may be two or more weeks out.

Best Management of Bulky Collections






Reduce Collections Demand

- Clearly define limitations
- Offer alternatives for self-haul
- Publicize alternate outlets/local reuse options

<u>Improve Materials</u> <u>Management</u>

- Charge proportionate to use most equitable
- Use supportive software to manage requests, scheduling, and fee collection

Fayetteville AR (2017)	N/A	8	PAYT
Grand Rapids MI (2019)	N/A	16	PAYT
Kingsport TN (2022)	199	580*	Large or No Limits
Sevierville TN (2022)	216	585	Large or No Limits
Chatham Co. GA (2023) (unincorporated)	121	58	Large or No Limits

*staff estimated share of co-collected bulk/brush
